Classification and Assessment of

Medication Risk in the Elderly



The TRHC Precision Pharmacotherapy Research & Development Institute

(PPRDI) recently presented a scientific poster at the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP) Midyear Clinical Meeting and Exhibition in December 2020. The poster summarizes a study on how polypharmacy and altered pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics contribute to adverse drug events (ADEs) in the elderly. ADEs lead to hospitalizations and poor outcomes, which decrease quality of life and increase medical expenditures.

The study also evaluated the MedWise Risk Score™ (MRS) and how it incorporates factors to compute risk of ADEs. The analysis suggests that patients with an MRS of 20 or greater and discharged home were 1.9-times more likely to be readmitted within 30 days. Thus, the MRS may help identify patients at risk for readmission, enabling resources to be devoted to the highest-risk patients. Peer-reviewed Study Shows Substantial Cost Can be Avoided When Incorporating Pharmacogenomics into Personalizing Medication Regimens in PACE



Nearly \$2,000 in annual cost-avoidance per participant per year

A Tabula Rasa HealthCare (TRHC) study, "Cost avoidance related to a pharmacist-led pharmacogenomics service for the Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly," recently published in the journal Pharmacogenomics, measured cost avoidance by evaluating the addition of pharmacogenomics (PGx) services to traditional medication comparison reviews. The study was a cross-sectional evaluation of data from a previously published study titled "Implementation of a pharmacist-led pharmacogenomics service for

the Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PHARM-GENOME-PACE)."

This cost avoidance study randomly evaluated 200 pharmacogenomic consultations completed by CareKinesis pharmacists for PACE participants who underwent PGx testing.

Additionally, MAC packaging is frequently easier to handle than other types of packaging, such as pouches, particularly for the elderly.

Richard Schamp, MD, Chief Medical Officer, and Nishita Shah Amin, PharmD, BCGP, BCPS, CMWA, Director, Pharmacy Practice Residency Programs, Tabula Rasa HealthCare (TRHC) recently examined current research into surface transmission of the novel coronavirus

blog). They found no published cases or evidence of medication packaging transmission occurring. In addition, most PACE participants serviced by CareKinesis have their medications delivered to their homes, further decreasing any risk of contamination.


